Federal grant proposals (all proposals to NSF, training proposals for NIH) normally include a requirement that all trainees are provided with instruction in the <u>Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR)</u>. An RCR program normally covers these areas: ethics, conflict of interest, responsible authorship, policies for handling misconduct, data management, data sharing, and policies regarding the use of human and animal subjects. UCLA utilizes the <u>CITI-hosted Responsible Conduct of Research Course for UCLA</u>.
